

4-Hers showcase your science, engineering and technology skills, win a cash prize, and help the Minnesota 4-H Foundation raise funds!

Task: Build a coin collection device that visitors to the 4-H building at the State Fair can drop spare change into. Creativity with moving parts and an entertaining display will draw visitors to your creation. Only safe, stable, durable and secure creations will be displayed. Creations must be appropriate for use by small children as well as adults.

Size: No more than 4' high, 2' x 2' base.

Power: No electrical power may be used. Battery power is acceptable but must last the duration of the State Fair.

Signage: Must include the words: "Make A Change With 4-H". If you intend to include the 4-H clover be sure to check guidelines for appropriate use.

Security: Entries must include a way to lock the change collection compartment as well as have access for removal of change.

Prizes: First place: \$500.00 Second place: \$250.00 Third place: \$100.00

Winners will be determined by the total amount of change collected during the MN State Fair, as well as the construction and creativity of the entry which will be judged by a panel of 4-H Foundation judges.

Winning coin collectors become the property of the MN 4-H Foundation to be used in other locations and at future state fairs to raise funds to support Minnesota 4-H.

Entry:

You must register your intent to enter by August 1, 2009.

You may enter as a club, small group or individual. All entries must be delivered to the 4-H building at the state fair at the same time as your county fair entries are delivered. A limited number of "Make A Change With 4-H" machines will be displayed. Once machines arrive at the fair a panel of judges will determine which ones will compete for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
