### **Four Dog Team Obedience Schedule – Saturday, September 26, 2009**

**Registration for 4-Dog Team will be 5:15 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. Judging will begin at 6:00 p.m.**

If you are not in Showmanship or regular Obedience classes you do not need to arrive until 5:15 p.m.

**Note:** Each team must provide a runner who will move with the team from ring to ring to complete the class. The runner is responsible for the score sheet and will give the score sheet to the judge in each ring and to the head ring steward when all the rings have been completed.

**Registration will be at 7:15 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. in the 4-H Building for the following Agility classes. Proceed to the Agility Ring where measuring will begin at 7:30 a.m. for Advanced Agility and 8:00 a.m. for the other classes listed below.**

The games are only open to 4-H'ers and their dogs that are registered for the Agility portion of the State 4-H Dog Show. Showmanship and Obedience classes will not be held up for anyone participating in Agility games. **Obedience and Showmanship classes take priority over Agility games.** The games offered are: Gamblers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker.

No ribbons are given for Rally – you will receive a participation item.

## Rally Obedience Exhibition – Sunday, September 27, 2009

If you are registered to participate in the Rally Obedience exhibition – Grades 9-13, check in at the registration table at 9:30 a.m. and then proceed to the Rally ring on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor where you will receive more information. If you are also in Showmanship, let the Rally ring know. Showmanship and Obedience takes priority over the Rally Obedience exhibition. The Rally ring will work around your schedule. No ribbons are given for Rally – you will receive a participation item.

### **Additional Agility Information For Both Saturday and Sunday:**

- ⇒ **Registration** – You will need to register and pick up your packet with your armband number in the 4-H Building. You will then proceed to the Agility-measuring area in the Agility ring where you will receive a sticker on your armband, which identifies your jump height.
- ⇒ **The Agility ring** is an outdoor ring. You may want to bring a tent or screen tent to provide protection from the elements (sun, wind, rain). However, you will need to work your stakes around the marked underground wires.
- ⇒ **Permanent Height Cards** – If you would like to get a permanent height card, please bring a 1¼" x 2½" side-view photo of your dog (dog only, nothing/no one else in photo). The permanent height card requires three certified judges' signatures received on three different days.
- ⇒ **Conflicts between Obedience or Showmanship classes and regular Agility classes will be worked out.** Please advise Agility Coordinator, Leona Hellesvig, and the ring stewards at your Showmanship and/or Obedience rings of potential conflicts upon arrival.

**Please remember to be flexible and courteous throughout the show. As with any schedule, adjustments may have to be made on show day. The judges will take a 30-minute lunch break when it is convenient to break their ring activities. We will do our best to make sure things run smoothly. We have made every effort to prepare for a successful show and we appreciate your cooperation.**
