NOTE TO FAMILY

Ownership Requirements Market heifers, beef steers, and dairy steers exhibited must be owned solely by the member or member's family. The family includes the 4-Hers parents or guardians and siblings living together as a family unit. The definition of family includes an extended family where the animals may be owned by grandparents with the 4-Hers parents actively involved with and working on the farm. Beef steers and dairy steers must be owned and identified by February 15.

Leasing Program: No lease option exists for market beef. See the Breeding Beef Affidavit for Breeding Beef Lease options.

Identification Details: All market heifers, beef steers, and dairy steers must be identified with a Minnesota 4-H ear tag. Animals shown at State Fair must carry the same identification all the way from February 15 to State Fair. If an animal's ear tag is lost, contact your County Extension Office or Regional Extension Office.

Be sure to follow your county's rules as to eligibility of animals and number of animals that can be identified per 4-Her.

Animals identified in previous years must be re-identified every year!
