

Truth or Manure

Instructions for getting ready for playing the Truth or Manure Game

Prior to playing the game with the youth that are participating in the Managing for Animal Care and Well-Being lesson you will want to do the following:

- Print all the Truth or Manure Question cards. You will want to print these cards back-to-back. It is easiest if you use perforated postcard type paper so they can be easily separated, or you can use regular cardstock paper and then cut the question cards apart. One set of these cards is needed for the session.
- Print enough of the Truth or Manure (Truth) cards and the Truth or Manure (Manure) cards so that each person in the session has one of each. These should also be printed back-to-back so that one side has the Truth or Manure logo on it and the other side has the word "truth" or the word "manure". Postcard type paper with perforations or cardstock should be used for these also. Each participant will need a truth card and a manure card for play.
- Print one set of directions.
