NOTE TO FAMILY

Ownership Rules of 4-H Dairy Goat Project:

Animals exhibited must be owned by the member, member's family or leased by agreement (only Breeding animals may be leased - if leased, complete information on back of page). The family includes the 4-Hers parents or guardians and siblings living together as a family unit. The definition of family includes an extended family where the dairy goat may be owned by grandparents with the 4-Hers parents actively involved with and working on the farm. Two current 4-H Dairy Goat Project Members from non-immediate families may own an animal together. However, said animal is the exclusive project rights of only one member in a given 4-H year. This ownership affidavit or the leasing form must be submitted to the County Extension Office/Regional Center prior to May 15. Junior Doe kids born April 1 – June 30 may be added until July 1. Animals need to be owned and identified prior to their first freshening. **Exception:** If a 4-H member has started their Dairy goat project with a goat(s) prior to first freshening and continues with the goat(s) for two years (through freshening of the goat(s) if appropriate) they then may purchase or lease goats that have been through first freshening.

Leasing Program: Leased breeding dairy animals must be recorded on the reverse side of this form. Leased animals must be identified by May 15. If a doe is ID'd and leased before her first freshening, when the lease expires she may return to the lessor's herd and be shown by the lessor's family. The doe needs to be ID'd on the family form by the lessor and ID'd on the lease form by the lessee.

Identification Details: Animals being shown at state fair must carry the same identification all the way from identification dates to state fair.

Animals identified in previous years must be Re-Dated every year!

The Owner Agrees To:

1. Retain title to the leased animal at all times.
2. Assume all legal responsibility as owner of the leased animal and not hold the Lessee liable for any injury to the animal or loss by death, except due to negligence on the part of the Lessee.
3. Incur all normal expenses in raising such an animal.
4. Refrain (cannot) from entering or exhibiting the animal during the time this contract is in effect.
5. Lease the animal for at least \$1.00 and sign this agreement

The 4-H Lessee Agrees To:

If this animal is shown/exhibited during the time frame of this lease agreement, it must be lead/exhibited in the ring by the 4-Her leasing the animal. See #4 above.

1. Assume responsibility for care and management of the leased animal when animal is in lessee's possession.
2. Refrain (cannot) from allowing any other individual to enter/exhibit the animal during the time this contract is in effect- See #4 above.
3. Incur all expenses in transporting and/or exhibiting the animal. The lessee may keep any premiums or awards earned while exhibiting the animal during the duration of this contract.
4. Breed the animal at the direction and the expense of the owner. The resulting offspring shall be the property of the owner who shall take possession of the animal at _____ days of age.
