

**Lunch Containers

17 year old Kari is looking for a lunch container that she can use to bring to her fall soccer practices and games. She will be bringing it to school in the morning. It is very important to Kari that her food stay cold and safe all day. She would like to be able to freeze juice or water to drink during practice. Kari would also like a container that she can put in her duffle when she travels or carry over her shoulder at a game.

Lunch Containers State Contest 2001 Senior Official Reasons

I placed this class of lunch containers for Kari 4-1-3-2. Upon analyzing this class I found all of the containers to be insulated which would keep Kari's food cold and safe.

In my top pair 4 places over 1 in an easy placing. 4 provides the most amount of space for Kari's food; has an attached, insulated space for her water bottle; and has a refreezable ice pack in it which would help keep her lunch cold. Both 4 and 1 had a shoulder-carrying strap.

In my middle pair 1 places over 3 because 1 has a shoulder strap. Granted both provide Kari with about the same amount of space for her food and 1 had the necessary shoulder strap.

In my bottom pair 3 places over 2 because it would be much easier for Kari to take to practices and games. 3 also provides her with more space for a water bottle and food.

4-1-3-2 is my final placing of this class.
