Placing: 3-2-1-4

Cuts: 4-5-1

I place this class of shoes 3-2-1-4.

In my top pair I place 3 over 2 because 3 fits all the requirements that Brianna was looking for. I criticize 2 because there is no heel on it and it is questionable if it is fashionable. Fashion is a matter of personal taste.

In my middle pair, I placed 2 over 1 because Brianna knows that 2 fits and it is more economical. Granted 1 is probably more fashionable and has a heel, I criticize it because of its expensive price and for the fact that she will not know if the shoe will fit until she gets it. IF the she does not fit, she may have a hassle with sending it back and finding another shoe that fits.

In my bottom pair, I place 1 over 4 because 1 does come in her size, has a heel and is fashionable. Granted, there is no time constraint on 4 and it is very cheap, it would be better for Brianna to take a chance with a shoe that might fit, rather than waste her money on one that does not fit.

I criticize 4 and leave it at the bottom of the class because it is not the right size, has no heel and is not very fashionable. Brianna would be very uncomfortable dancing in these shoes.

For these reasons, I place this class of shoes 3-2-1-4.
