This \$750 scholarship is in memory of Lyle Lamphere, long-time supporter of agricultural activities in Minnesota and, for many years, secretary of the Minnesota Livestock Breeders' Association. Mr. Lamphere was a former Vocational Agriculture teacher, Pepin Wisconsin County Extension Agent and a 38 year employee of Central Livestock Association in South St.Paul. He assumed major roles in livestock improvement programs, cattle feeders' clinics, meat-type hog shows, Future Farmer marketing schools and the Minnesota 4-H Market Livestock Show and State Fair Purple Ribbon Auction.

A student may be awarded the Lamphere scholarship only once and cannot be awarded the McKerrow scholarship in the same year.
